TEAM INFORMATION

ENTRY FEE:

A \$50 entry fee will be charged for each team participating. Prizes will be awarded for both the Judges' Choice, the People's Choice and the Best Booth Décor. Entry Fee must be paid by October 7th, 2017

TENT / ELECTRICITY

Our tent will be located in the parking lot of Landmark Booksellers, 114 E Main Street. Each team will be allocated a 10' x 10' space under the tent. Only electric or chafing dish heat is allowed per Franklin Fire Department code. **PROPANE IS PROHIBITED** **Each team MUST BRING A 100' EXTENSION CORD.** 110v electricity will be provided. One 8' table & 2 chairs will be provided per team.

SET-UP / TAKE DOWN

Set-up begins at 9:00am, Saturday, Oct 28th. Teams will have 2 parking spaces for the event in the parking lot of Landmark Community Bank, entrance from 2nd Ave N, the day of the event. Load out will begin at 3:30pm (after the awards ceremony). Serving time will be from 11:00am to 3:00pm.

TEAM RESPONSIBILITY

Teams will be responsible for all ingredients for their chili, all equipment to maintain and serve the chili, a 100' extension cord, and booth design/decorations. Teams will be responsible for **making and serving 15 gallons of chili** to be portioned out in 2 oz. servings for tasting by judges and the ticket holders. Chili should be prepared prior to the cook-off with proper storage and service provided by each team. Participants are encouraged to be creative in designing/decorating their space, as awards will be given for the best decorated booths.

DFRC will provide serving cups, spoons, napkins, crackers & large trash cans.

Ticket holders will receive only one (1) sample of your chili. Two representatives of your team must be present at your booth at all times.

Judging and Awards

First and Second-place awards will be given for *Best Chili – Judges*, *Best Chili – People's Choice* and *Best Booth Decoration*. Each person purchasing a Chili Cook-Off ticket will have a vote for the People's Choice award. Judges will come to your booth at various times between 11:00 – 2:00. Winners will be announced at approximately 3:30pm.
